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ABOUT THE EVENT

Our Trunk Sale is a Community Yard Sale, Flea Market, Swap Meet

A trunk sale is a type of market where individuals come together to sell used household and garden goods. The idea of a trunk sale is that people will be selling items from the car's trunk. There is typically a small portion of professional sellers that will sell new product.

There are 165,000 yard sale type events in the Unites States weekly. It is estimated that 690,000 people purchase something at those sales. These bring it \$4,222,375 of revenue each week.

This is our 4th annual year hosting this event. In 2023 we had about 400 people attend. Vendors were happy with the event and were able to sell a lot of their items. They asked if we could do more shows like this over the spring/summer. We plan to continue to grow the event to a large capacity where people save their items throughout the year and plan to attend the event to sell them at the event.

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The event is located in our east parking lot which becomes the perfect location for people to pull in, open their trunks and sell their items. We have additionally expanded the event to our neighboring parking lot at City Hall. The parking lot typically has vendors and we have a few select locations for sponsors. When you apply to be a Sponsor at the Trunk Sale, and you plan on having a booth at the event, you will receive a vendor kit. This kit comes in your email one (1) week prior to the event and will include everything you need to know about your spot at the Trunk Sale.

Load in is May 18th, 7:00 AM



POLICIES & PROCEDURES:

1. EXHIBITOR AGREEMENT

a. The Exhibitor agrees to (i) obey all laws, by-laws, ordinances and regulations governing use of the facility and operation of the Show,
(ii) abide by the rules and regulations of the city, fire and police departments and of any other government or regulatory body having authority to regulate the facility and the Show, and (iii) obey all laws, including those pertaining to health and safety, consumer protection and protection of visitors of the Show.

b. The Exhibitor agrees to abide by all rules and regulations governing the Show established from time to time by Nampa Civic Center ("NCC") including rules and regulations set forth in the Exhibitor Manual.

c. The Exhibitor agrees to obtain, at its own expense, any licenses or permits which are required for the operation of its trade or business during the term of the Show and to pay all taxes, including all applicable sales taxes, of any nature or kind that may be levied against it as a result of the operation of its trade or business in its contracted space.

d. The Exhibitor agrees not to conduct or be associated with any promotional contests held at or in connection with the Show unless
(i) the Exhibitor satisfies NCC that the contest is being operated in accordance with applicable law; and (ii) the prior written consent of NCC is obtained.

e. The playing, performing, reproduction, broadcasting or other use at the Show of any music, materials, devices, processes and dramatic rights (the "Work" that is the subject of any third party copyright, trademark, industrial design, patent or any other intellectual property right, by the Exhibitor or its agents representatives or employees is prohibited without the express written consent of NCC. The Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and save harmless NCC and the facility (and their respective officers, directors, employees, insurers, agents, representatives and those for whom the Exhibitor is responsible in law) against any and all claims, losses, liabilities and damages (including legal fees and expenses) costs and charges arising from or as a result of any unauthorized use of any Work by the Exhibitor its agents, representatives, employees and those for whom the Exhibitor is responsible in law.

2. NCC RIGHTS

a. NCC reserves the right, in its sole and unfettered discretion to: (i) determine the eligibility of Exhibitors and exhibits for the Show, (ii) reject or prohibit exhibits or Exhibitors which NCC considers to be contrary to law, common decency or good morals or otherwise improper or detrimental to the reputation of NCC, as determined in NCC's sole discretion; (iii) change or modify the layout of the Show and/or relocate exhibits or Exhibitors; (iv) cancel, in whole or in part the Show; or (v) change the date, location and duration of the Show; all without any obligation or liability to NCC.

 b. NCC shall have the right to establish and amend or modify any regulations governing use of the facility and the Show.
 3. ASSIGNMENT

The Exhibitor shall not assign any rights or sublet space under this Agreement without the prior written permission of NCC, which permission may be withheld in NCC sole discretion.

4. INDEMNIFICATION

The Exhibitor agrees to indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless NCC, Canyon County, City of Nampa (the "County"), County officials, including without limitation the County Board of Supervisions, and any other present or future lender providing financing to the County in connection with the construction or operation of the facility, and each of their respective officers, directors, partners, agents, representatives and employees, against all claims, losses, liability, damages (including legal fees and expenses) costs and charges of every kind resulting from (i) any breach of this Agreement by Exhibitor, (ii) Exhibitor's use and occupancy of the exhibit space and/or its environs, (iii) the use of equipment or devices furnished to or used by the Exhibitor or other persons in connection with the Show, and (iv) personal injuries, including, without limitation, death, property damages or any other damage sustained by the Exhibitor, NCC, the facility, Show sponsors or a visitor to the Show and their respective directors, officers, agents, representatives and employees or those for whom the Exhibitor is responsible in law. Neither NCC nor any of its officers, partners, employees or agents

shall be responsible or liable for any loss or damage to the personal property of Exhibitor or its employees or agents in connection with Exhibitor's use of the facility hereunder. Exhibitor acknowledges and agrees that all of its property or property of others in the facility shall be used and/or stored in the facility at the sole risk of Exhibitor, and Exhibitor hereby waives and releases NCC, and the County from any and all claims or costs related thereto to the fullest extent permitted by law.

Exhibitor acknowledges that this Agreement imposes no contractual obligations upon the County, unless, until and only if the County expressly assumes in writing the obligations of NCC hereunder pursuant to the provisions of that certain the Management Agreement dated May, 2017, by and between the County and NCC (the "Country Agreement").

6. EXHIBIT DISP

a. All racks must look professional and be well constructed. 10x10 popup tent allowed, must be in excellent condition. NCC will provide (1) table linen/skirt per table upon request Should you choose to use your own: All tables must be professional skirted with floor length, fire

resistant skirting that is pleated or gathered. No plastic or paper tablecloths are allowed.

The Exhibitor agrees that no display will be

dismantled or goods removed during the term of

the Show, but will remain intact until the end of the

final closing hour on the last Show day. The Exhibitor

also agrees to remove its display and equipment from the Show site by

the final move-out day, and in the event of a failure to do so, or failure

to return the allocated space to the same condition as the move-in date,

the Exhibitor agrees to pay for any additional costs and expenses incurred.
7. CANCELLATION

The Exhibitor shall have the right to cancel this Agreement by notice in writing to be delivered to NCC no later than sixty (60) days preceding

the opening date of the Show. All deposits received by NCC up the

date of notice of cancellation are non-refundable and nontransferable. 8. NO AGENCY

The relationship between NCC and Exhibitor is that of

independent contractors and not agents or employees. Under no circumstances shall this license be considered a contract of partnership or joint venture. Neither party shall be liable for any of the debts, accounts, obligations or other liabilities of the other party, its agents or employees, and neither party shall have any authority to obligate or bind the other party in any manner except as may be expressly provided herein. Further, no agent, servant or employee of Licensee or any of its subcontractors shall under any circumstances be deemed an agent, servant or employee of Licensor.

9. ATTORNEYS FEES

In case any suit or action is instituted by either NCC or Exhibitor to enforce compliance with this Agreement, including all appeals, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses from the losing party, in addition to the costs and disbursements provided by statute.

10. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement is entered into in the State of Idaho and, in the event of any controversy or litigation, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaho, without regard to its principles of conflicts of laws. Any action arising out of or in connection with this Agreement or the conduct, acts or activities of the parties hereunder shall be brought in the federal or state courts located in Canyon County, Idaho, and the parties hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of those courts and consent to venue in those courts for any such actions or proceedings.
